

Key Stage 2 Reading and Comprehension

This exciting and enjoyable 15 lesson course is aimed at students in primary school. It covers skills from the National Curriculum Course for Key Stage 2 in the United Kingdom.

The focus of this course is to teach students key skills for reading and answering comprehension texts and questions. Skills learnt will include inference, skimming, scanning and answering the question succinctly to gain maximum marks in future examinations.

We have included a range of comprehension articles in this course, including fiction and non-fiction topics. The last lesson will focus on exam techniques, using Key Stage 2 level comprehension exam questions.

Students will have a pre-reading activity to complete before each lesson and a written homework.
